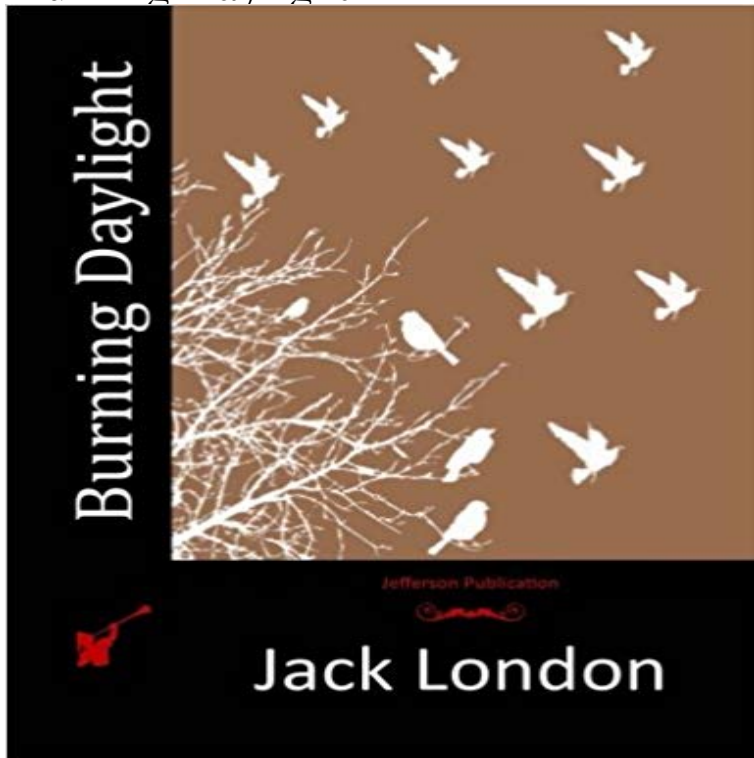


Burning Daylight
