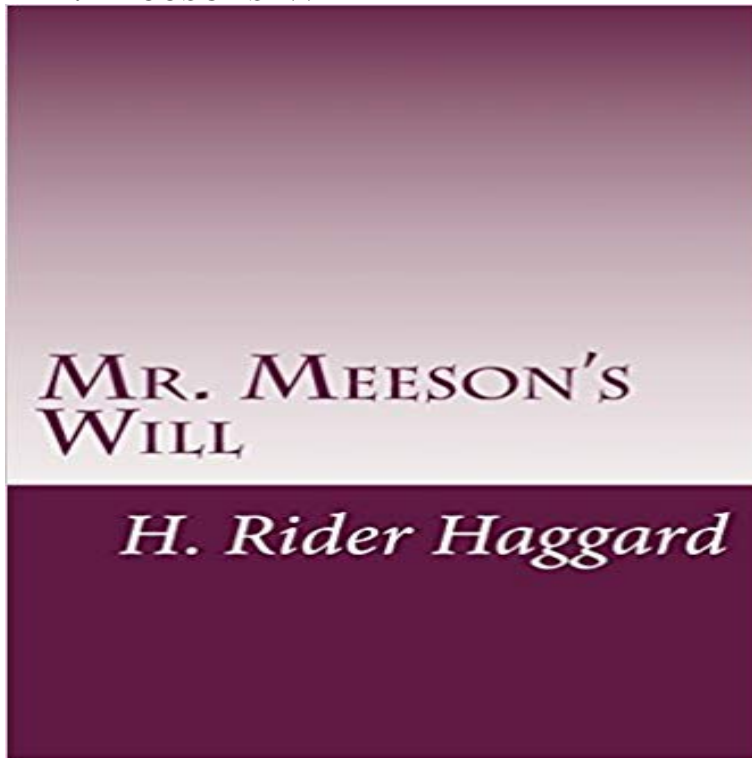


Mr. Meesons Will
