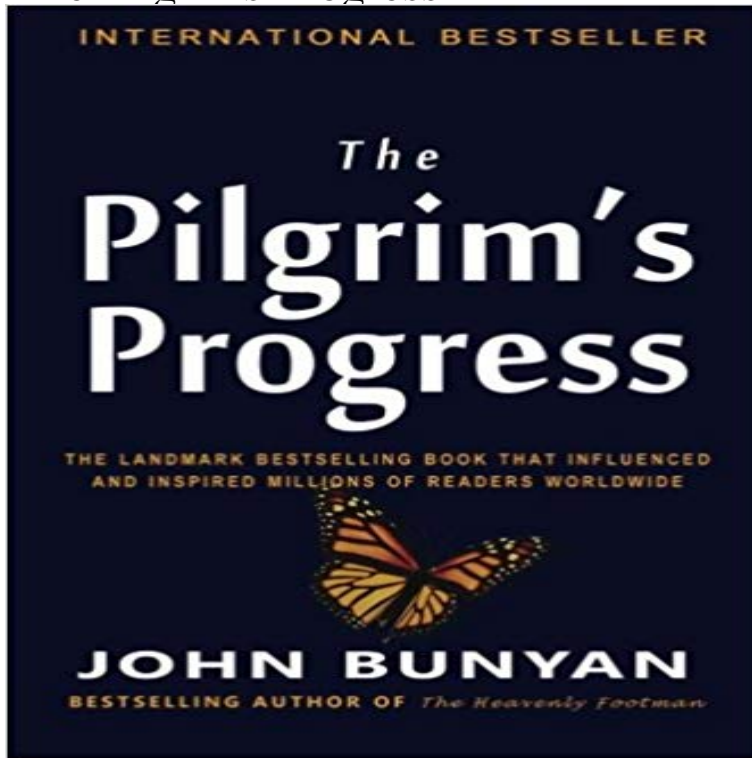


# The Pilgrims Progress
