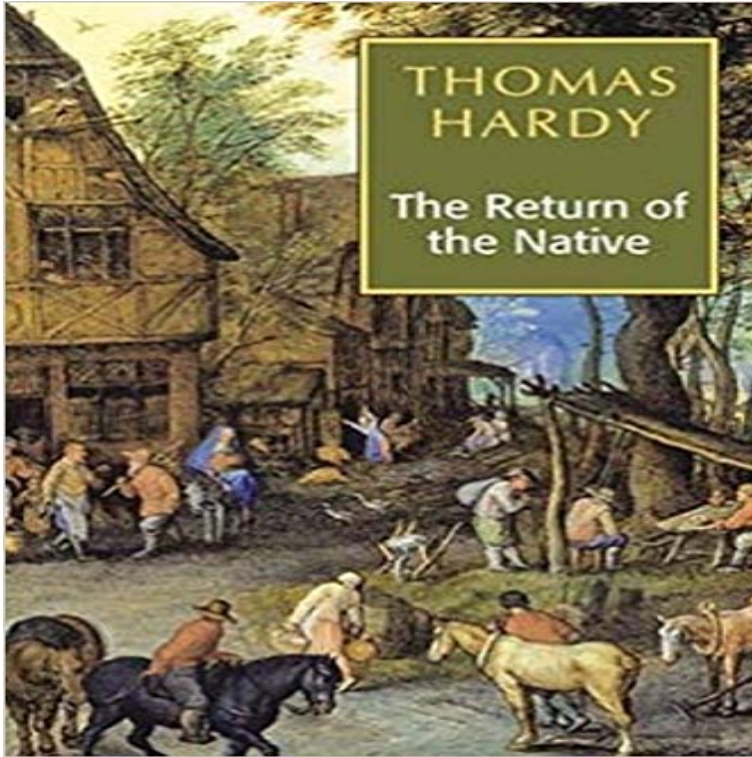


The Return of the Native
