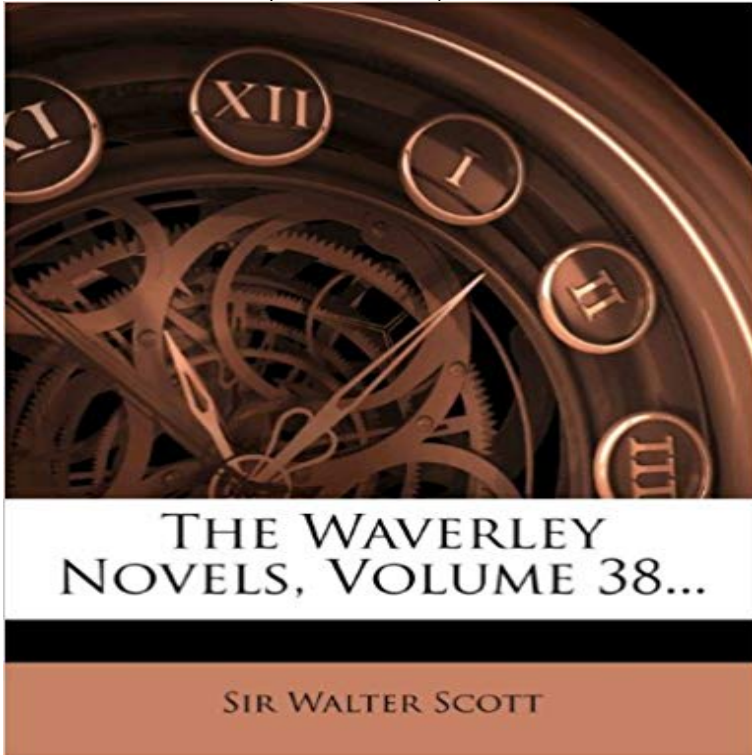


## The Waverley Novels, Volume 38...
