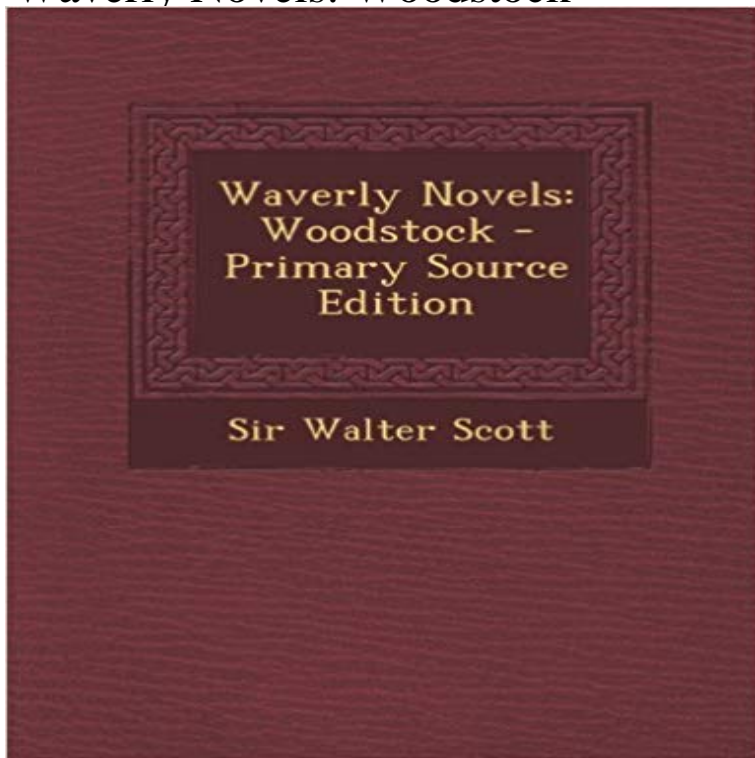


Waverly Novels: Woodstock
