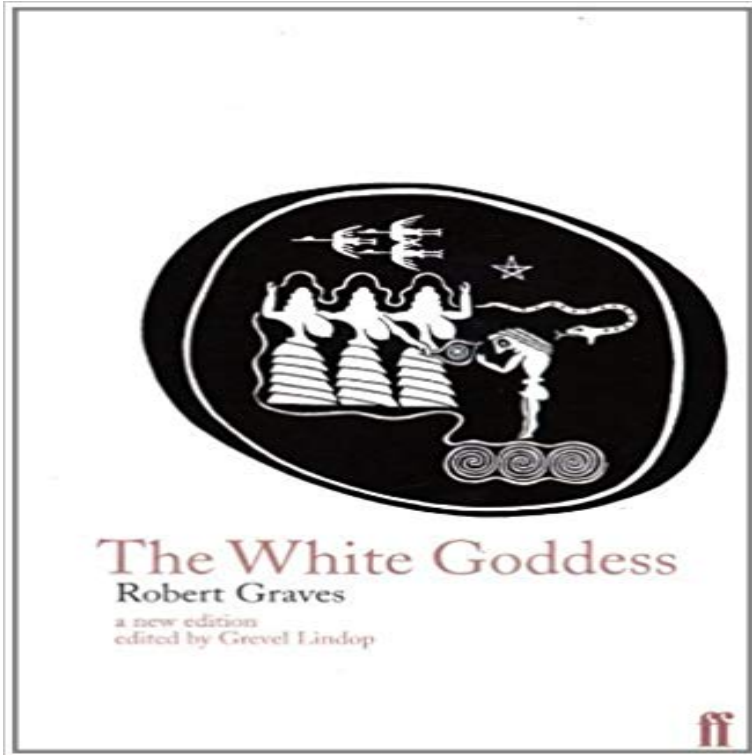


# The White Goddess: A Historical Grammar of Poetic Myth
