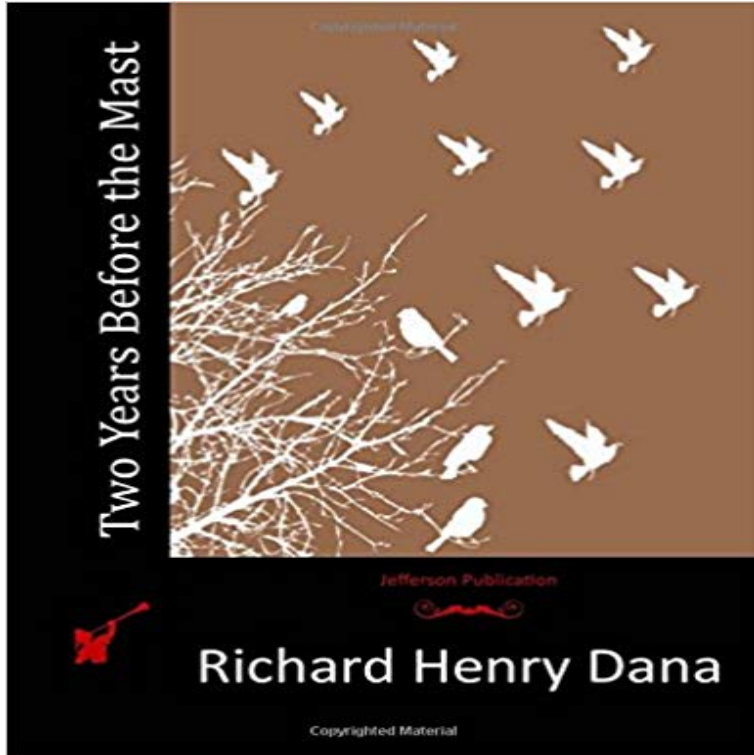


Two Years Before the Mast
