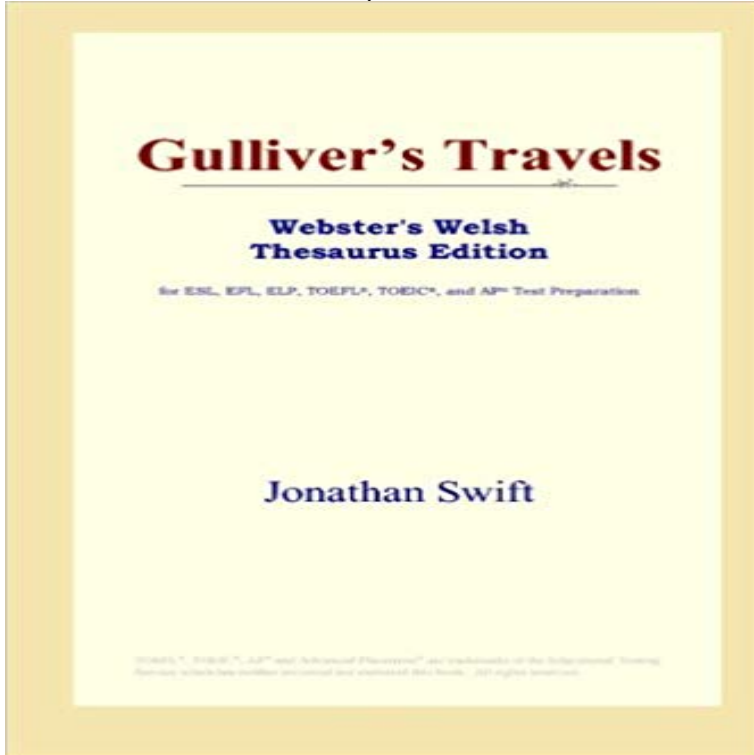


Gullivers Travels (Websters Welsh Thesaurus Edition)
